LAKESIDE STREETSCAPE PROJECT

A RESOLUTION OF BOROUGH COUNCIL OF BLOOMFIELD BOROUGH, PERRY COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION FUND (MTF) PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION TO THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AUTHORITY AND DESIGNATING OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL ASSOCIATED GRANT DOCUMENTS.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bloomfield, Perry County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough") desires to pave and resurface the streetscape in its entirety and add sidewalks to bring up to code within the section of the Borough known as Lakeside Development. Project includes: Barnett to Locust Street; Timber Circle; Lakeside Drive (Barnett St. to Timber Circle), Lakeside Drive (to Dead End), Patio Court and the addition of sidewalks that were previously omitted by the former developer prior to the Borough assuming ownership of the streets following determination by Commonwealth Court.

WHEREAS, the Borough and its representatives have identified the Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF) Program, a grant program administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation ("PennDOT") as a potential source of grant funding for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that implementing the Project will benefit the community; and

WHEREAS, the MTF grant program requires a resolution formally requesting the grant, briefly describing the project scope, designating officials to execute all documents, and identifying the grant amount requested.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Borough Council of Bloomfield Borough as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Bloomfield Borough Council hereby supports the Project and authorizes and approves the submission of the Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF) Program grant application for the Project, whereby the Borough will be the Applicant and Grantee.
- 3. The Borough hereby requests a grant of up to \$400,000 from the Pennsylvania department of Transportation to be used toward advancing the Project.

- 4. In addition to MTF grant funds, the Borough shall seek additional local, state and federal funding sources for the Project as appropriate.
- 5. Should the MTF grant be awarded by PennDOT and accepted by the Borough, the Borough pledges to provide any matching funds necessary (30% of the final Grant) to secure the grant and ensure Project completion.
- 6. Borough Council hereby authorizes the use of the engineering firm (HRG) to provide a formal cost estimate and final design that is signed and dated as required for submission in accordance with PennDOT guidelines.
- 7. The Borough hereby designates the President of Borough Council as the official authorized to execute all documents and agreements between the Borough of Bloomfield and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
- 8. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
- 9. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
