**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION
TO THE COVID-19 CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND MULTI-PURPOSE COMMUNITY
FACILITIES PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE BLOOMFIELD
MUNICIPAL BUILDING.**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council recognizes its responsibilities for the betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bloomfield is desirous of applying for a \$540,000.00 grant from the Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority, for COVID-19 ARPA Capital Projects Fund Multi-Purpose Community Facilities Program funding; and

WHEREAS, the funds will cover the costs associated with the engineering, design, and construction necessary to ensure the Bloomfield Municipal Building is accessible and compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), thereby enhancing the availability of community services to all residents and fostering a more inclusive and engaged community; and;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Bloomfield of Perry County hereby requests a COVID-19 ARPA Capital Projects Fund Multi-Purpose Community Facilities Program grant of \$540,000.00 from the Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority to be used for the Bloomfield Library Accessibility project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Malinda C. Anderson, Council President, and J. Kevin Fitzpatrick, Council Vice President, as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between the Borough of Bloomfield and the Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
