RESOLUTION #2025-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BLOOMFIELD, PERRY
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING THE COMPENSATION AND
BENEFITS OF THE TAX COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council (“the Borough”), by virtue of the Laws and Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including Section 36.1 of the Local Tax Collection Law (72 P.S. § 5511.36a), as the same may be hereinafter amended, is empowered to determine and set the compensation for the Borough’s Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to determine and set specific fringe benefits for the Borough’s Tax Collector effective February 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Borough finds it in the best interest of its residents to codify the compensation and fringe benefits provided to the Borough’s tax collector.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated by reference thereto.

Section 2. **Compensation.** The Borough’s Tax Collector shall be entitled to such financial benefits as required by law. Pursuant to Section 35 of the Local Tax Collection Law 72 P.S. § 5511.35, the Borough’s Tax Collector shall receive a sum not exceeding five per centum of all Borough’s taxes received or collected from the Borough. The Borough’s Tax Collector shall be allowed such actual printing and postage expenses as shall be incurred in performing the duties for the Borough prescribed in the Local Tax Collection Law.

Section 3. **Fringe Benefits.** The Borough’s Tax Collector shall be provided a cell phone, full access to printing, a laptop or other similar computer equipment, and office space in the Borough Building located at 25 E. McClure Street, New Bloomfield, PA 17068.


Section 4. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and approval.

Section 5. **Severability.** The provisions of this Resolution shall be severable. If any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 6. **Repealer.** All resolutions, parts of resolutions, and correspondence inconsistent herewith shall be and the same hereby expressly are repealed or, in the case of correspondence, withdrawn.
