

Items Accepted at Bloomfield Borough Recycling Collection Center

1st Saturday of every month, beginning October 1, 2022

***Please note, recycling is for Bloomfield Boro residents only – proof of residence will be required (Drivers license or mailing address)

*** Please keep items accepted in separate containers. If materials are not clean and sorted, you will be required to sort and to clean them, not the volunteers. No items will be accepted if they are not on the list. The items cannot be contaminated.

Aluminum Cans

Rinsed and crushed.

Bi-Metal (tin) Cans

Newspapers , Magazines

Tied securely with twine may also be stacked in paper bags

Glass Bottles

Cardboard

Flattened cardboard, cereal, food boxes and shipping boxes. NO PACKING MATERIAL.

Plastic Containers & Bottles

#1 PETE All #1 containers including soda and small water bottles, narrow necked beverage containers.

#2 HDPE #2 natural, example: Clear milk and gallon water containers

#2 HDPE #2 colored such as detergent bottles and white or yellow milk bottles

** #5 & #7 are also accepted

Bloomfield Boro Recycling Center is manned by volunteers. If there are no volunteers on recycling day, the center will remain closed. We encourage the residents to bring materials in containers that they can reuse. If your recyclables are brought in plastic bags, please be aware that you will be required to take the plastic bags home with you. Please DO NOT have trash in with your recyclables.
